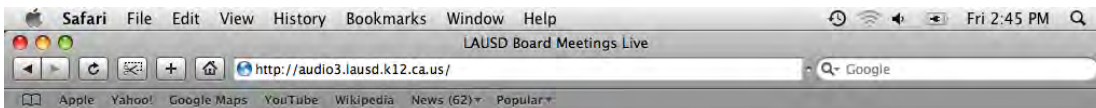

1. Launch Safari



2. In the address bar enter the URL below and press Enter:

3. Click on the link labeled "Click Here to watch our meetings here – live!" this will automatically launch the Apple QuickTime application.

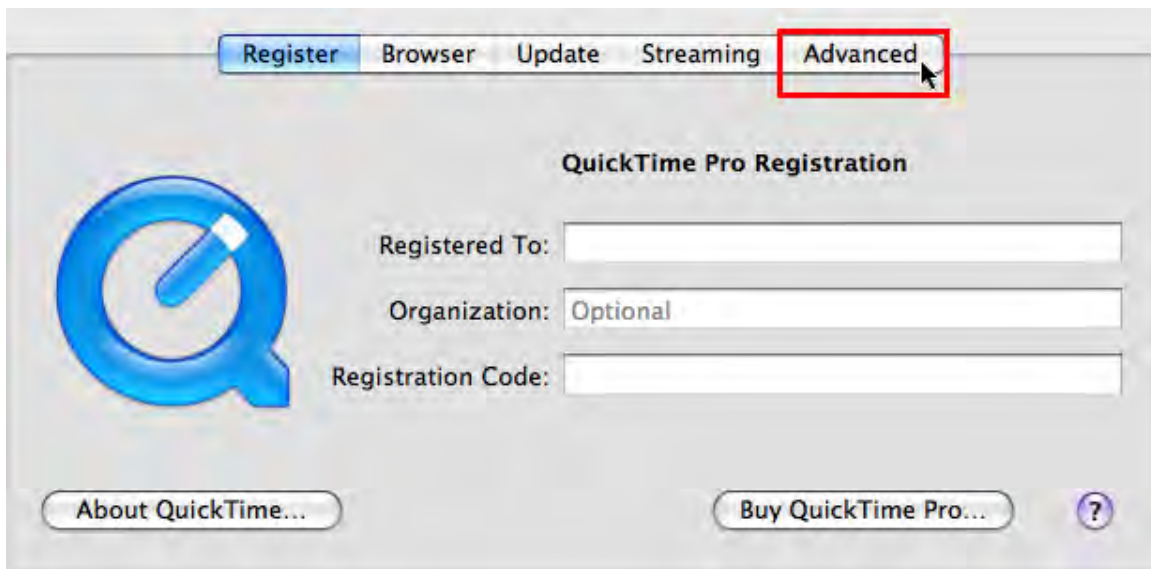

For optimal viewing behind a firewall, choose Streaming Transport from the QuickTime Settings, and set to HTTP, Port 80. [Click here for instructions](#)

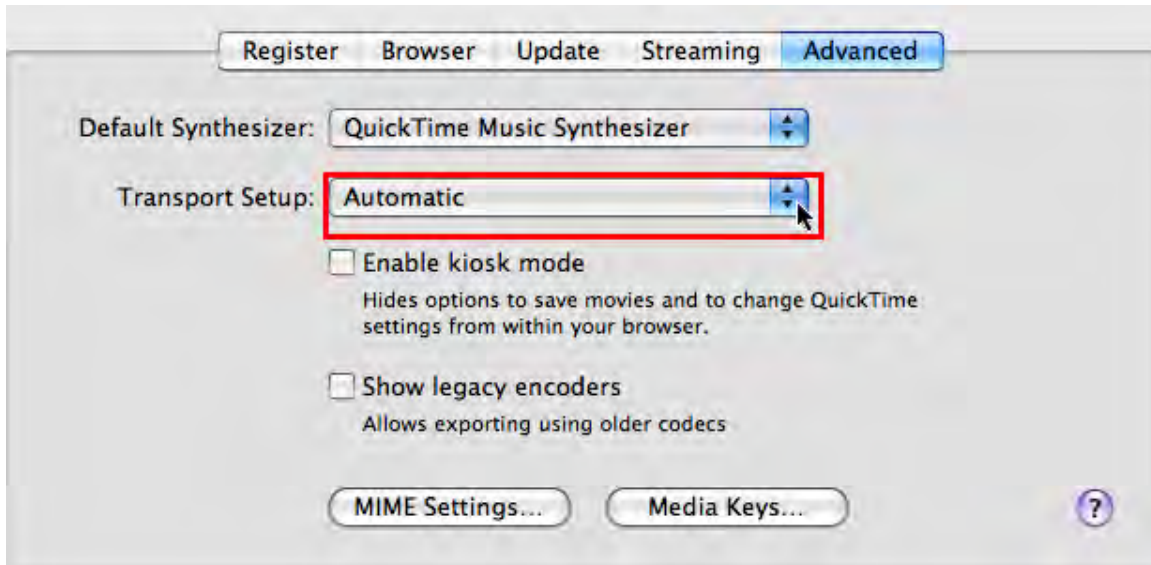
4. The QuickTime application will launch and show a blank page. Click on “**QuickTime Player**” located on the top left and then select “**QuickTime Preferences**” option.



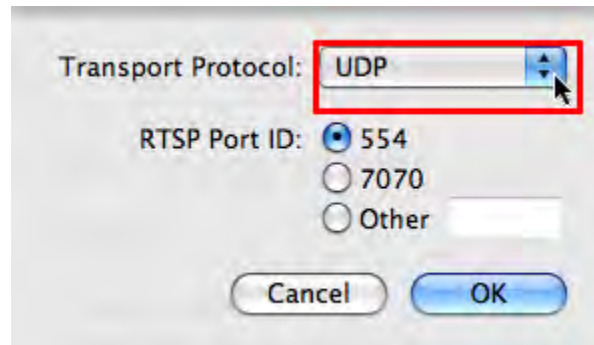
5. Click on “**Advanced**” option.



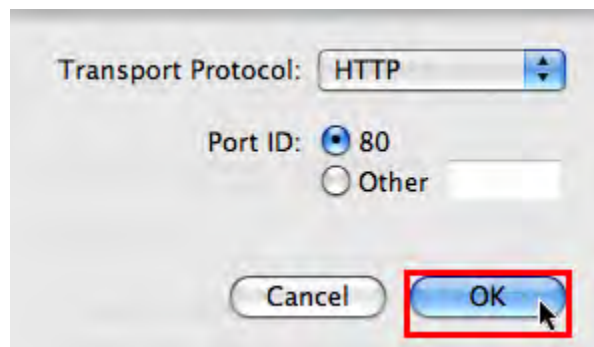
6. Click on the **Transport Setup** menu bar.
7. Select **Custom**



8. Click on the **Transport Protocol** menu bar.



9. Select **HTTP** and Verify that port **80** is selected.



10. Click **OK**

11. Close the QuickTime preferences by clicking on the red **X** located on the top left.
12. Click on **Play**
